Student Life Disability Services (SLDS) collaborates with students, faculty and staff to enable equal access to all aspects of university life. We encourage students with disabilities to register with SLDS to be considered for accommodations. Disabilities include, but are not limited to, mental health conditions, chronic health diagnoses, ADHD, physical and/or learning disabilities and temporary injuries or conditions.

Accommodations

Students can request approval for accommodations at any time while at Ohio State. Our SLDS team works with students to facilitate reasonable accommodations, such as:
